Today we invite you to read the results of the survey and to consider the timeline that summarizes our plans. The committee continues to welcome your comments, questions, and ideas.

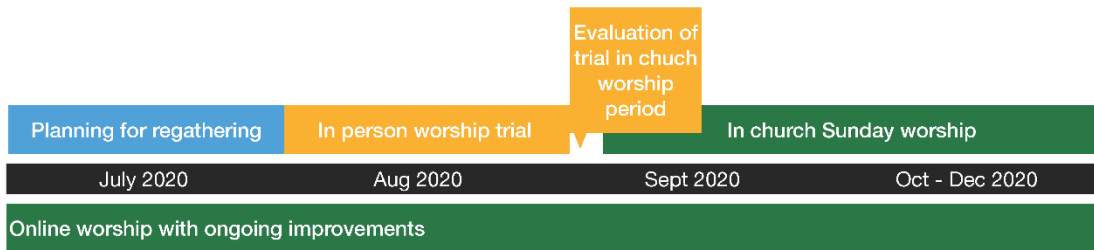

## SURVEY RESULTS

The Regathering Committee thanks all those who completed the Regathering survey. We are using your feedback to help us plan for in-person worship.

The results showed that:

1. You want to begin to worship again together again and be in communion with each other. We are preparing for in-person worship that includes a trial period during August.
2. You value your own safety and that of others as we begin to worship together. To provide improved safety, special cleaning protocols, a system of reservations for attending services, and monitoring of temperatures on entry to the church are being introduced.
3. Some members would prefer to continue online church services. Improvements are being planned to the equipment and platforms that are in use for online church services. These improvements are intended to enhance the sound and quality of the online experience.
